Cabin-to-cabin garbage pickup is expected to begin July 3.

IMPORTANT FOR CABIN OWNERS

Campground garbage cans are for campground guests only and may NOT be used for regular household cabin garbage.

Please help keep campground sites clean and available for visitors by using the designated garbage disposal locations.

Until then: Household garbage may be disposed of at the dumpsters located approximately 350 metres past the gate on the right-hand side.



RECYCLING OPTIONS



SMALL RECYCLING BINS

Located throughout the campground and beside the store.



Accepted:

- ✓ Beverage cans
- ✓ Beverage bottles
- ✓ Refundable drink containers

Refundables can be returned to SARCAN in Kyle.

LARGE BLUE TRIWAY BINS

Located beside the store.



Accepted materials include:

- ✓ Cardboard & boxboard
- ✓ Paper & mixed paper products
- ✓ Plastic containers (accepted by recycling program)
- ✓ Tin & metal food containers
- ✓ Other approved household recyclables

Please place ONLY recyclable materials in these bins.



NO household garbage • **NO** food waste • **NO** furniture
NO construction materials • **NO** yard waste
Contaminated recycling may result in additional costs to the park.



LANDFILL PASSES

For larger or non-household loads, landfill passes are available at the office.

\$25
PER LOAD

Valid for one trip to the RM landfill.

GOLF CART REMINDER

All golf carts operated within Clearwater Lake Regional Park must comply with park regulations.

- ✓ Display a current registration sticker/permit
- ✓ Have valid liability insurance
- ✓ Be operated by an approved driver
- ✓ Follow posted speed limits and park rules
- ✓ Drive safely and respectfully

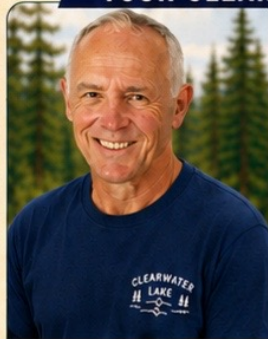

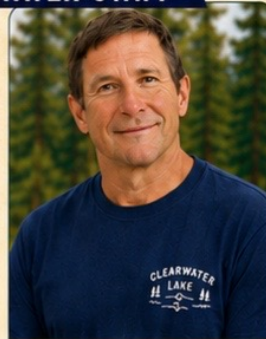
You'll usually find me answering emails, helping visitors, or chasing coffee around the park.
